


Table 1: Tripod Mount Type

Key Features

- 1 x 1/4-20 UNC 2B threaded hole for attaching the tripod mount adapter to a tripod with a matching top attachment screw.
- 4 x Ø6 through holes for attaching an ace 2 camera to the tripod mount adapter. The holes correspond to the different hole patterns for ace 2 GigE and ace 2 USB cameras. Attaching a camera involves three screws.
- 3 x cap head hexagon socket screws. These included screws are required for attaching an ace 2 camera to the tripod mount adapter.










Fig. 1: Tripod Mount Dimensions (in mm); Not to Scale
